Parking Restrictions

Some areas around the stadium, including areas within the parking zone, are reserved for public transport and other traffic management uses. Eden Park Zone A Permit Holders are not able to park in these areas. These areas are marked on the map and will be clearly signposted on the event day.

Residents' Parking

Zone A of the residents' only parking scheme will be in operation from 6.00PM – 11.00PM.

Parking in Zone A will be permitted for vehicles displaying:

- A valid Eden Park Zone A parking permit

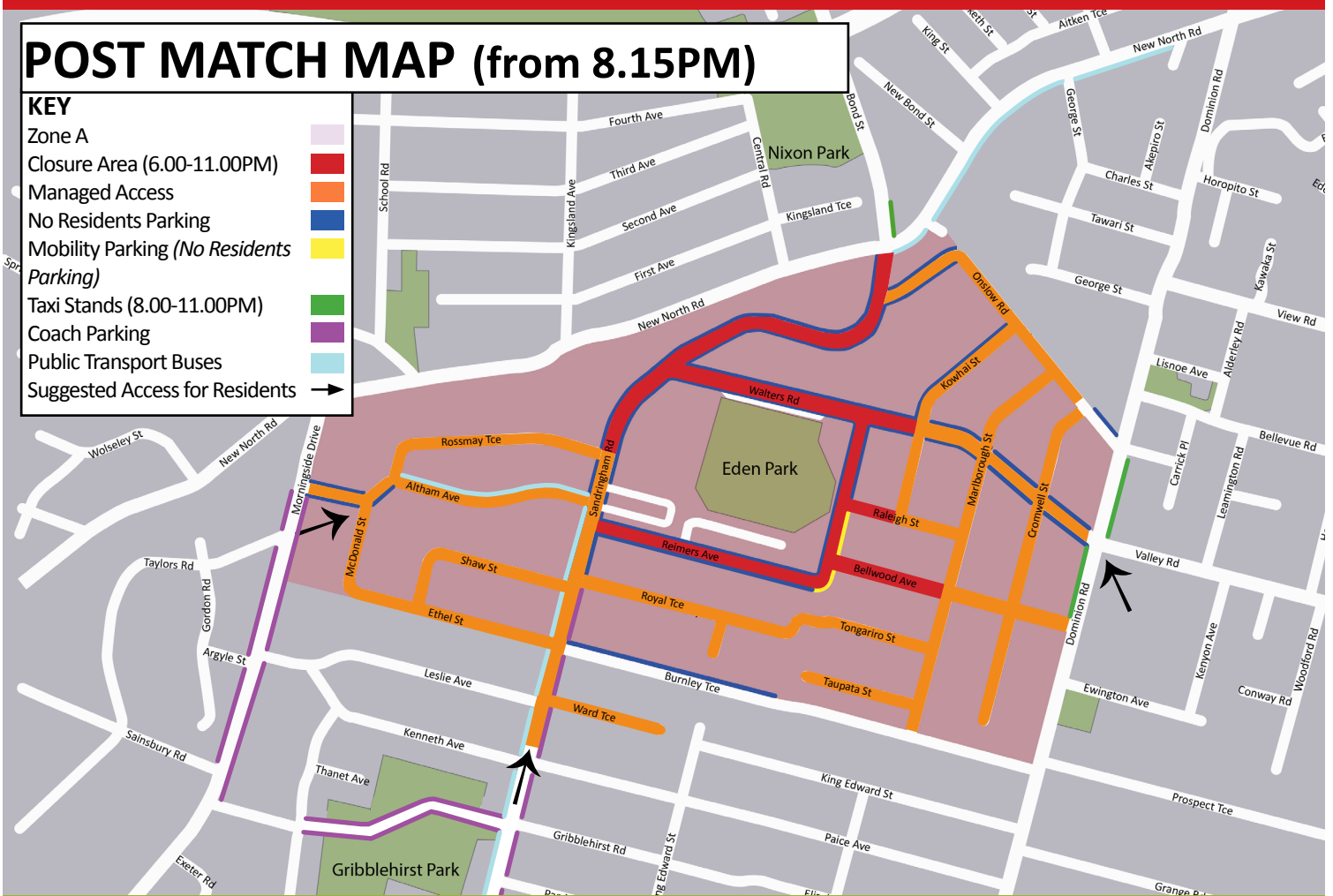

PRE & POST MATCH INFORMATION

Residents and your visitors will have access at all times unless it is unsafe at the managed closure points (please see below where access is not available). For recommended access points please see the pre and post closure maps.

Please note

- Due to safety requirements for anticipated crowd numbers there will be NO access from the intersection of New North Road and Sandringham Road from 8.15PM — 11.00PM. For residents on Sandringham Road (between Onslow and Walters Roads), access will be off Dominion Road, taking Walters Road, Kowhai Street, Onslow Road and left onto Sandringham Road.
- For up to 30 minutes post match, pedestrians will take priority over cars in the closure areas for obvious safety reasons. Your patience is appreciated. Would you please ask visitors to restrict their movements during this time.
- **Please note, for public safety, changes may have to be implemented on game day without notice.**

Sound Checks

Eden Park will be undertaking sound checks between 4.00PM - 5.00PM on Friday 24 February 2012.

Liquor Ban

The Eden Park Major Event Liquor Ban will be implemented with additional signage and personnel in place to enforce the ban. If you have any concerns on the night of the event with people drinking outside your property please call us on the HOTLINE.

Toilets and Rubbish Bins

Additional rubbish bins and temporary toilet facilities will be placed around the outer environs of Eden Park and a clean-up of the area will be undertaken on the morning of Saturday 25 February after 8.00AM.

Towing

If you or your visitors are parked in Zone A without a valid Parking Permit you will be towed. Even if you have a valid Parking Permit displayed, if you or your visitors are parked on a street marked "No Resident Parking" you will be towed. For vehicle recovery, please call Auckland Council (09) 301 0101.
